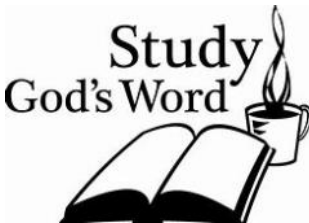

Weather permitting, Parish Bible Study is on Tuesday evenings at 6:30 at the Elimsport church. We are continuing in the Book of Psalms.

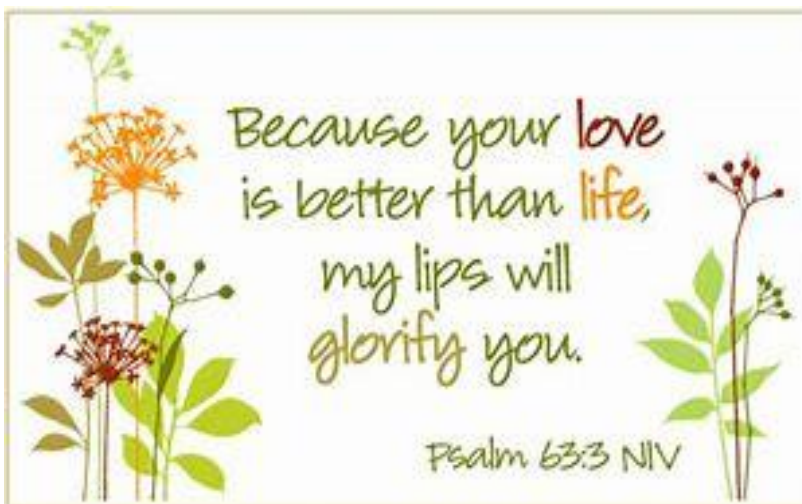
