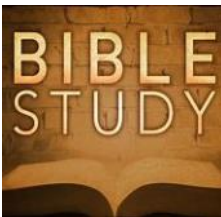


Calling all Superheroes interested in exploring epic adventures to discover their strength in God!!!

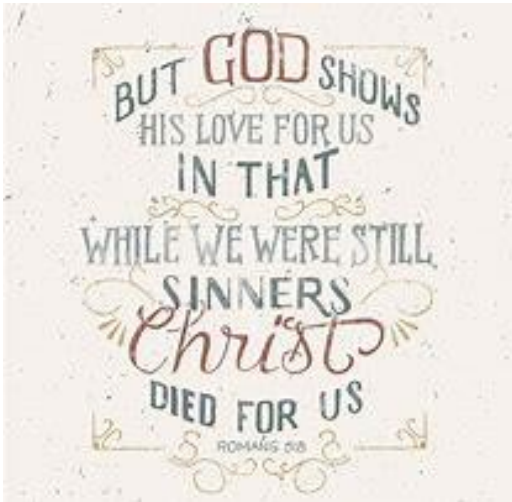
### Mission Statement of St. John's UMC
