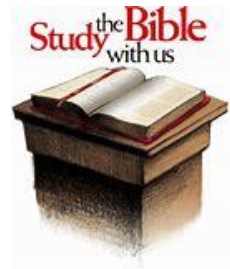
- **Have a Blessed Day**
