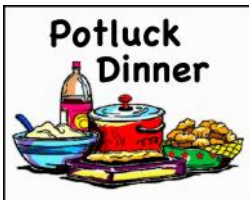
All children up to Kindergarten age (5) are invited to come to the nursery after the children's chat, during the hymn.
