

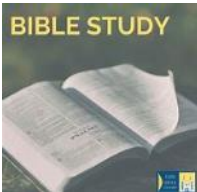

United Methodist Home offers a wide range of programs and services to meet their individual and group needs. The home remains grounded in vital basic principles: youth, family, faith and community.
