

Peanut Butter Eggs

Ingredients:

1/4 cup butter, softened

1/2 pound cream cheese, softened

1/2 cup to 1 cup peanut butter

1 1/2 pounds confectioners' sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Semi Sweet Chips

Instructions:

Cream together first three ingredients until very soft. Add sugar, salt and vanilla. Shape into eggs and chill. Melt chocolate coating slowly over low heat. Coat eggs and refrigerate.



JELLY BEAN BARK INGREDIENTS:

- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1-1/4 pounds white candy coating, coarsely chopped





 Line a 15x10x1-in. pan with foil; grease foil with butter. In a microwave, melt candy coating; stir until smooth. Spread into prepared pan. Top with jelly beans, pressing to adhere. Let stand until set. Cut or break bark into pieces. Store in an airtight container.



Coconut Cream Eggs

INGREDIENTS:

8 oz softened Cream Cheese

1 tbsp softened Butter

4 cup Powdered Sugar

1 cup Shredded Coconut

1 tbsp Shortening

2 cup Semi Sweet Chocolate Chips

DIRECTIONS:

Using a hand mixer, beat cream cheese and butter until blended.

Incorporate powdered sugar and coconut.

Refrigerate for 1 hour or until easy to mold with hands.

Prepare a baking sheet by lining with wax or parchment paper.

Dust your hands with powdered sugar and mold mixture into egg shapes.

Place on a prepared baking sheet.

Place in freezer for 2 hours or until eggs are firm.

Melt chocolate chips and shortening in microwave by heating for 30 seconds then stirring and repeating until melted and smooth.


Dip eggs into chocolate mixture insuring that they are completely coated.

Place back on prepared pan.


Refrigerate until hardened.











