

We want to say thanks to the Drick family for helping make the hayride a great success. We had approximately 50 people on the wagons and we had a beautiful night for fun and fellowship.




Wednesday Breakfast

Marshmallow Sweet Potatoes

1/2 c. Flour 1 tsp. Cinnamon 1/2 c. Brown Sugar 1/3 c. Oleo

1/2 c. Oatmeal

-Mix until crumbly

-Add 2 (17oz) cans of sweet potatoes

-Add 2 cups cranberries

-Cover with rest of crumb mixture

Bake at 350 for 35 minutes Cover with marshmallows and brown.






