



STREAK FREE CLOTHS STILL AVAILABLE

The Pine Grove Bed and Breakfast Cheese Casserole

5 slices of buttered bread—good crusty bread with lots of air pockets

3/4 lb. extra sharp cheddar cheese—coarsely grated

4 eggs

2 cups milk

1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce or Hot Sauce

Butter deep casserole dish (soufflé dish) along the bottom and sides. Tear bread into chunks. Layer bread and cheese in casserole dish, two layers each.

Whisk together eggs, milk and Worcestershire sauce. Pour over bread and cheese. Cover with foil.

Refrigerate overnight. This can also be put together in the morning and cooked in the evening.

Bake in 350° F oven for 40 minutes; remove foil and bake uncovered for 20 minutes for a total of 60 minutes.
